


Strategy 2026 – we shape the future of intermodal transport

- > Political advocacy to improve modal shift conditions and grow capacity




Strategy 2026 in numbers

- Modal shift $1,1 \rightarrow 1,6$ million trucks p.a.
- CHF 300 million investment with focus on terminals, digitization, railcars
- 7 major new terminals / expansions
- Achieve 90% punctuality by 2026






Hupac Strategy – bridging the gap between reality and expectations

Total new capacity 1.300.000 loading units Total investments EUR 500 million










Corridor Rhine Alpine: political support to remove 71 km bottleneck. More capacity and quality of transalpine traffic
